What your project is about?

Community development. The project is about creating a business franchise model for parliamentary representation utilising contemporary communication and social media to reinvigorate democracy and public engagement while reinforcing the responsibility, of us all, for the choices that determine the type of society we and our children live in.

Specifically the project seeks to develop a freely available software (CMS) based toolset that allows an individual to effectively represent any parliamentary constituency through discussion, deliberation and decision making in an evolutionary process of consensus building.

As part of the development the project would create partnerships and business relations with financial institutions toward the development of a secure transaction platform to gather votes and deliver ballot outcomes. This is premised on the adaptation of existing personal banking accounts to include simple transaction accounts to collect, tally and provide historical statements of activity relating to votes on relevant issues. It also provides the countries best security as well as enabling us to confidently confirm voter's identities without compromising their privacy.

The franchise is self funding as each vote is in effect a 50c deposit, a percentage to the bank and the remainder to the pollee.org business manager. The pollee manager and parliamentary representative must simply maintain the site and contribute a percentage of poll turn-over towards the licensing and development of the franchise through Pollee.org. Pollee.org is a not for profit political organization, promoting non party politics and fully engaged democracy, open and accountable to all. In the eventuality that it achieves funding this status will be made as official as it needs to be.

Who are you, your background and where in the world are you located?

I am Andrew Chambers, freelance event manager and production designer based in Broome WA, Australia. I have 30 years experience in producing events and since 1985 have been promoting the concept of digital democracy having run for state parliament in 2000 under the votedave franchise, an early underfunded, under resourced, under publicised iteration of the ideas and principals outlined in the project description

Your Funding Goal and what rewards are you planning to give back to your supporters?

The principle funding goal, \$105 000, is to employ a team of software developers to research the best CMS package and then develop the templates that will provide a freely available franchise for anyone choosing to nominate as a digital democrat. This funding

request also provides the means of support for one year of operation, promotion and publicity such that the franchise can be legally established, effectively promoted, distributed and supported.

This budget is as tight as I know how but then I profess to knowing very little and would presume less. This is a project you commit money and love to because you want to do something about the great malaise afflicting our politic and society.

If you know something that can make this project work better, faster and brighter then do the democratic thing and participate. Our planet needs consensus, not conflict, which is what digital democracy is all about, deciding on real issues through discussion with friends or icons using whatever media in the digital and analogue world you find most appropriate.

Rewards for supporters?

The satisfaction and probability that they are contributing to the evolution of our democracy. (To the point that we have an alternative to government by politicians sitting in a bipolar parliament.)

It might be an old fashioned ambition but I believe that we should do what we can to leave the world a better place than we find it. This vision has been at the core of all our great communications developments and something that I believe anyone that still has hope would hold as a worthy and noble aspiration.

As a secondary benefit; it's a ground level entry for anyone seeking an interesting and engaging new career, as a truly representative politician.

Business Plan / Site Development Notes:

This is one proposal for development of the site by a local developer based in Broome. I believe in supporting my local businesses. This is a guide to what a business charges, there may well be better and easier ways to do this. I'm uncertain of what platform but know there are many amazing possibilities. This is a necessary part of the discussion.

Chris has chosen to base the proposal on a licensed CMS from Adobe, Business Catalyst. This is a closed and proprietary system which as a pro means some certainty of support, at a price.





